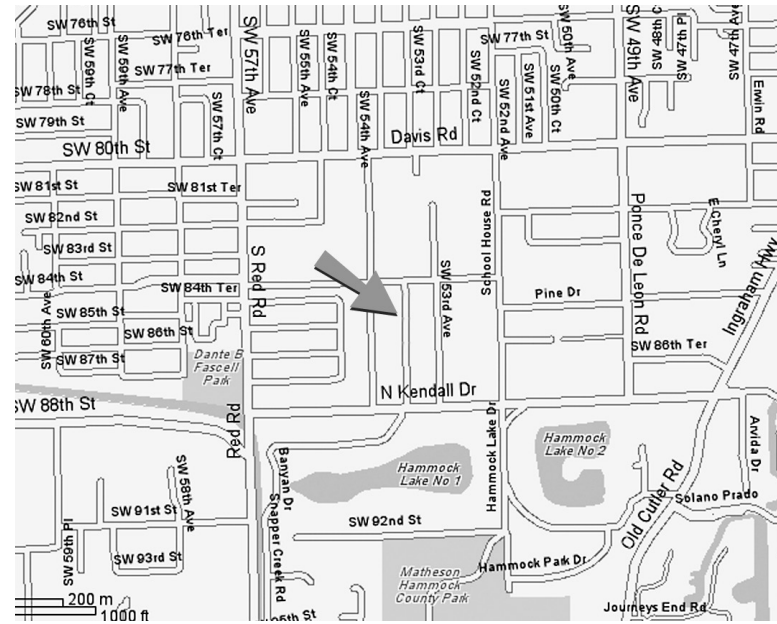

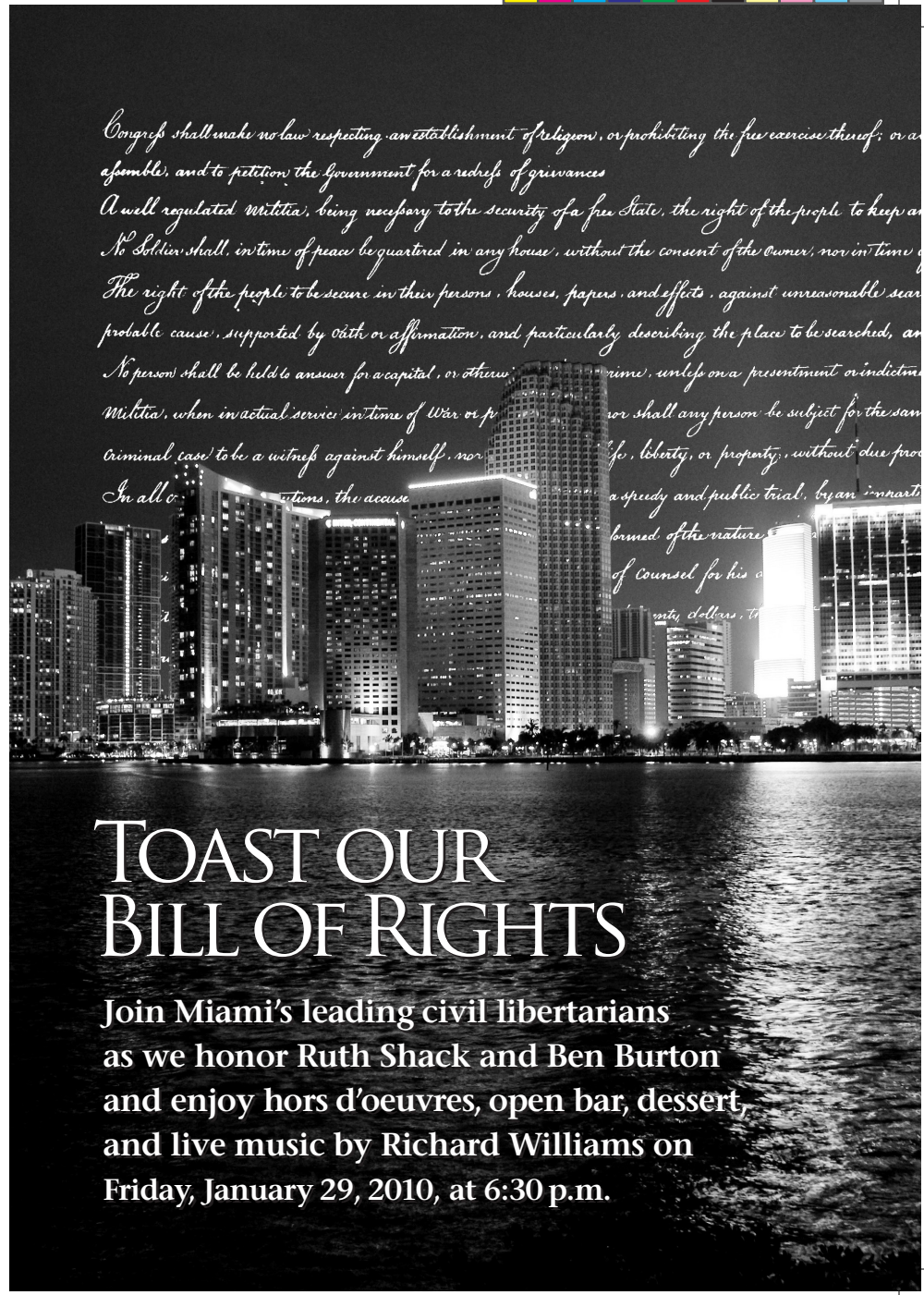

*Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or a  
assembly, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances  
A well regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep an  
No Soldier shall, in time of peace be quartered in any house, without the consent of the owner, nor in time of  
The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable search  
probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and  
No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment  
militia, when in actual service in time of War or public Danger, nor shall any person be subject for the same  
criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor shall any person be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process  
In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right of a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury  
of the nature and composition of the crime, to be informed of the charges against him, to confront the witnesses  
of Counsel for his defense, to compel the attendance of witnesses, and to have the assistance of counsel, if he be  
indigent, and to have the benefit of the writ of Habeas Corpus.*

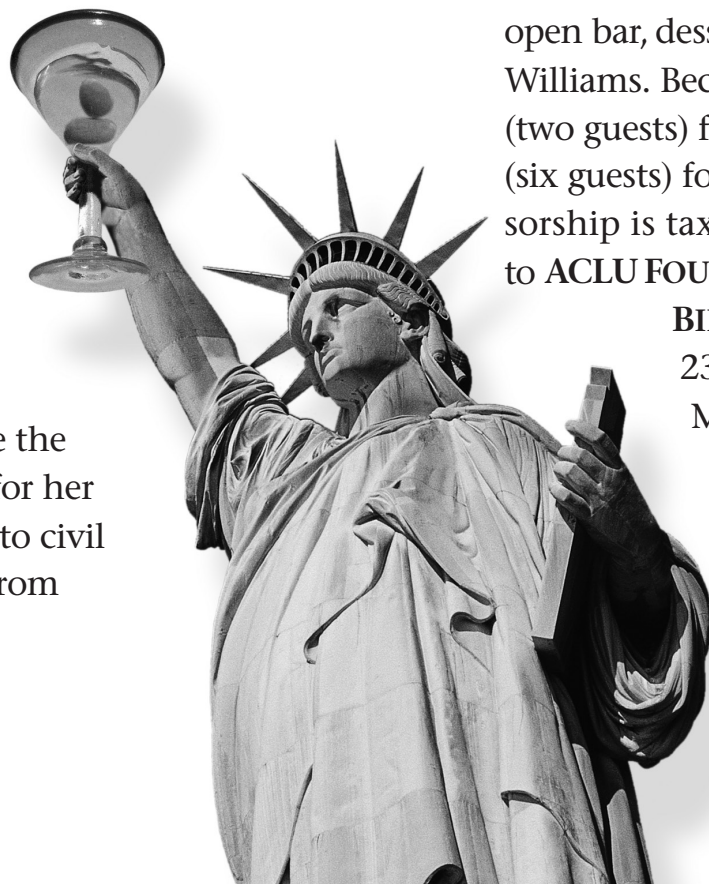
